04	Trim trees and branches near your house and enclosure	<input type="checkbox"/>
05	Take photos of your property for insurance documentation	<input type="checkbox"/>
06	Review your homeowner's insurance and coverage	<input type="checkbox"/>
07	If you have a generator, make sure it is working properly	<input type="checkbox"/>
08	Store important documents and valuables in waterproof containers	<input type="checkbox"/>
